## Professional Summary

I am a radiologist with fellowship-trained subspecialty expertise in musculoskeletal imaging and intervention. I am the Deputy Chief of the Department of Radiology, Changi General Hospital and am Director of Musculoskeletal Radiology of the department. I am a Fellow of the Royal College of Radiologists (United Kingdom) and a Fellow of the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists. My academic appointment is that of Clinical Senior Lecturer with the School of Medicine, National University of Singapore.

I completed my fellowship training in musculoskeletal imaging and MRI research at the Hospital for Special Surgery in New York, and a fellowship in spine imaging and intervention at the Seoul National University Hospital in South Korea.

One of my skills is in technical aspects of MR imaging. Aside from being able to operate an MR scanner, I am proficient in optimising scan protocols and in introducing new techniques such as hepatic MR elastography and spinal DTI. I have carried out technical evaluations of various MR scanners for procurements by the hospital. I am the radiologist-in-charge of supervising MRI and DXA services in the department.

Apart with interventional procedures of the extremities, I also have strong interest in interventional pain procedures of the spine. My skillset includes diagnostic and therapeutic image-guided procedures such as epidural injections, facet injections, medial branch blocks, discographies, sympathetic blocks, spinal biopsies and vertebroplasties.

I am active in and hold appointments in various administrative, educational and research activities. Among these are the musculoskeletal section radiologist in-charge, core faculty of the ACGME-accredited radiology residency programme and chairperson of the hospital's radiation safety committee. I am interested in information technology and have been involved in research investigating the potential clinical use of tablet devices. I was also responsible for designing and maintaining the website of the Singapore Radiological Society.
